The Woof Top can be used as a Long Dog Carrier for Yuba's full size cargo bikes or as a Short Dog Carrier for both Yuba's compact and full size cargo bikes. Your setting will depend on your

Required for install:

Allen Keys

8mm Wrench (only Boda Boda

Contents: 6 M5x20 Screws

4 M5 Lock Nuts

6 M6x20 Screws

4 M5x12 Screws 8 Medium Washers

2 Spring Clips

Installation:

To assemble the Woof Top, install the tubes together at the chosen lenght by pressing the spring clips. Then bolt the tubes on the base

plates as shown on the pictures.

Remove the bolts and nuts from the bike deck as necessary. Place the Woof Top on the deck so the slots align with the holes. Assemble the hammock on the frame as it is shown below. For the shorter version, fold the hammock on itself to make it shorter. Insert the M5x20mm or M6x20mm screws (depending of your Yuba bike) through the washers, hammock, base parts, top deck and into the frame. IMPORTANT : Always use the WoofTop with an adapted deck (If you use the long lenght version on a Spicy Curry, please install the "Longtail Deck" instead of the normal Spicy Curry Deck)


Secure with locknuts (Only Boda Boda V2) or with low strength locking adhesive

Tighten to 4Nm of torque.











Instructions:

We developed the Woof Top with the advices of dog trainers. It is why we encourage you to use a harness with two attachment loops (one on the chest and one on the back) to safely attach your dog on the Woof Top.

To get your dog on the Woof Top, ask it to jump on it from the back, or carry him on it if it is a small dog.

Use the three straps to attach the harness and tighten them to adjust their length to your dog's size.


You can use the cover to close the rear hole or to protect your dog from rain/sun.

Use the short version of the cover if the Woof top is in short position.


To make the short version, fold the end band twice consecutively.

To make the back version, fold so that sides 1 and 2 are against each other and then sides 3 and 4.

Then attach to the nearest textile loop (depending on the configuration of your dog carrier*)







How to make your dog confortable with the Woof Top?

If it is your first ride, your dog might be afraid of being on a bicycle. Follow those steps to assure a good and safe ride:

- Assemble the Wooftop on the ground, without the bike and get your dog used to going on it and lying down. You can place its blanket or toys on the hammock first, to make the dog comfortable.
- Install the Woof Top on your Yuba with the stand and do the same exercice. You can use food to encourage your dog to jump and lie down.
- Once it is comfortably installed, push the bike slowly, in a quiet area.
- Then you can take your first ride. It is good to keep an eye on the dog's behaviour at the beggining, it can be stressed or react dangerously if it sees a cat or another dog.

In any case, your dog might be stressed and nervous while learning, so be patient and calm and give it enough time to get used to it. Make sure each step is completed before moving on to the next one to give the dog confidence.

Confirm the WoofTop is secure and enjoy the Ride!

WARNING:

The dog must remain lying down when the bike is in motion

Check bolts, velcros and straps frequently for loosening or signs of damage regularly.

If bolts shows signs of damage, replace parts immediately.

Make sure to use a suitable harness with two attachment loops (one on the back and one on the chest)

- WARNING! Failure to comply with these instructions may lead to serious injury or death.
- WARNING! Riding with a heavy dog will alter the riding characteristics of your bicycle, decrease the stability, and increase braking distances.
- WARNING! Never leave your dog unattended on the back of your bicycle.
- WARNING! Do not use with turbulent dogs, or aggressive towards people or animals.
- Do not allow dog's tail, or personal items to come in contact with moving parts of the bicycle
- Never ride in inclement or hazardous situations.
- Ensure a rear reflector is installed and visible when the dog is on the WoofTop.
- Never ride a bicycle at night without adequate lighting.
- Presence of an additional weight may require alteration of the method used by the rider to mount or dismount the bicycle.

Additional hardware and component warnings

- · WARNING! Use Wheekskirts or wheel protection when riding with dogs.
- · Make no modifications to the WoofTop.
- Check deck and Wooftop for signs of wear and tear. Do not use if deck is cracked or Wooftop is damaged.
